Agency Spotlight: Caritas of Austin

For more than 50 years, Caritas of Austin has served people without a stable place to call home, making sure they have access to safe housing, jobs, healthy food, and life skills to thrive.

Lunch in Caritas' Community Kitchen is open to anyone who is hungry. A staff chef and 8-10 individual or group volunteers help prep and serve 300-350 meals every weekday. The Caritas of Austin team uses a mix of donated food along with items from the Central Texas Food Bank and

other grocery stores to come up with a balanced daily menu.



All of Caritas' housing services begin with Coordinated Assessment, a community-wide tool that prioritizes the most vulnerable people experiencing homelessness for housing services. Once a client is enrolled in the appropriate housing program, they work collaboratively with their case manager to develop goals around regaining housing stability, increasing income, and restoring overall health and wellbeing. Caritas of Austin's

comprehensive service model also includes employment assistance, life skills and workforce development classes, and food assistance from the Caritas Pantry. Each client household can make 10 self-shopping visits to the Caritas Pantry for groceries as they transition from crisis to stability.

Since 1974, Caritas of Austin has also provided resettlement services to hundreds of refugees annually. Staff members help with everything from picking newly arrived refugees up at the airport and arranging their apartment, to cultural orientation classes, community resource connection, and employment assistance during their first months in Austin. Regional deliveries will not be rescheduled, but agencies who usually receive deliveries may schedule a pick up at Central Texas Food Bank as our schedule permits.

 May 25 by 9:00 a.m.
- If you are ordering a pick up or delivery on Wednesday, May 31, your order is due on Friday, May 26 by 9:00 a.m.
