

COMMODITY SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM: CSFP ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

The Central Texas Food Bank partners with the Texas Department of Agriculture to provide the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) to eligible seniors 60 years of age and older. The food items included in the CSFP box are U.S. Department of Agriculture products. Therefore, in order to participate in the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP), seniors must qualify by meeting USDA's Income Eligibility Guidelines.

How do I know if I meet the Age Requirements for CSFP?

Applicants who are 60 years of age or older meet the age requirement to participate in the CSFP. Applicants must provide proof of identification to prove that they meet the age requirement. Valid forms of Identification include:

- Driver's License
- State ID Card
- Birth Certificate
- Permanent Resident Card
- Passport
- Military ID
- Refugee Visa
- Baptismal Certificate
- Health Card

How do I know if I meet the Income Eligibility Guidelines for CSFP?

Using the chart below, find where the number of people in your household intersects with your household's gross income. Please note that SNAP benefits do not count as income. If the total dollar amount is equal to or below your household income, you meet the income requirements to participate in the Commodity Supplemental Food Program.

You may have heard that you are required to provide proof of income. However, as of July 10, 2019 you do not need any proof of income to qualify for CSFP. You simply have to declare your household's gross income.
