Whole Grains



Make HALF your grains WHOLE! • Check for “100% Whole Wheat” or “100% Whole Grain” as the **first ingredient** on the label



Low Sodium



Aim for less than 2,300mg of sodium per day • Choose foods with a daily value of 5% or less per serving



No Sugar Added



Limit calories from added sugars • Read the ingredient label on processed foods to identify added sugars

Health and Hunger in Central Texas

Health

About **80%** of our clients had to choose between paying for food and paying for medicine or medical care in the past year.

38%

of HH have at least one member with **diabetes**

61%

of HH have at least one member with **high blood pressure**

33%*

of individuals in our service area struggle with **obesity**

34%

of HH **lack health insurance** of any kind



**33% is the county average across our service area

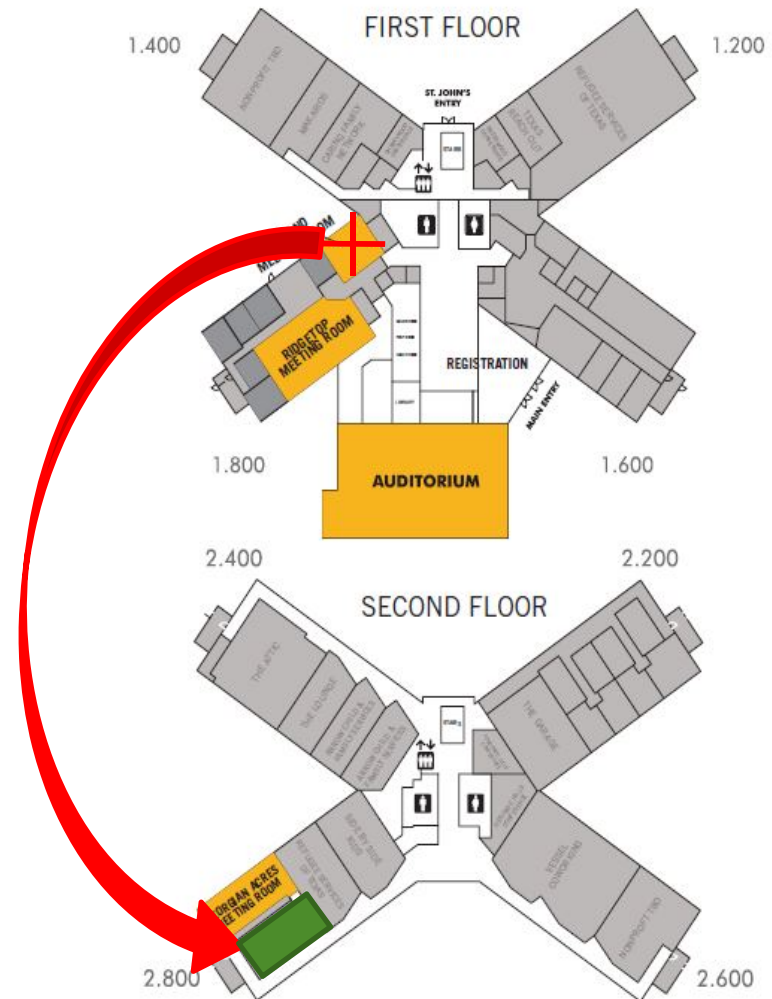

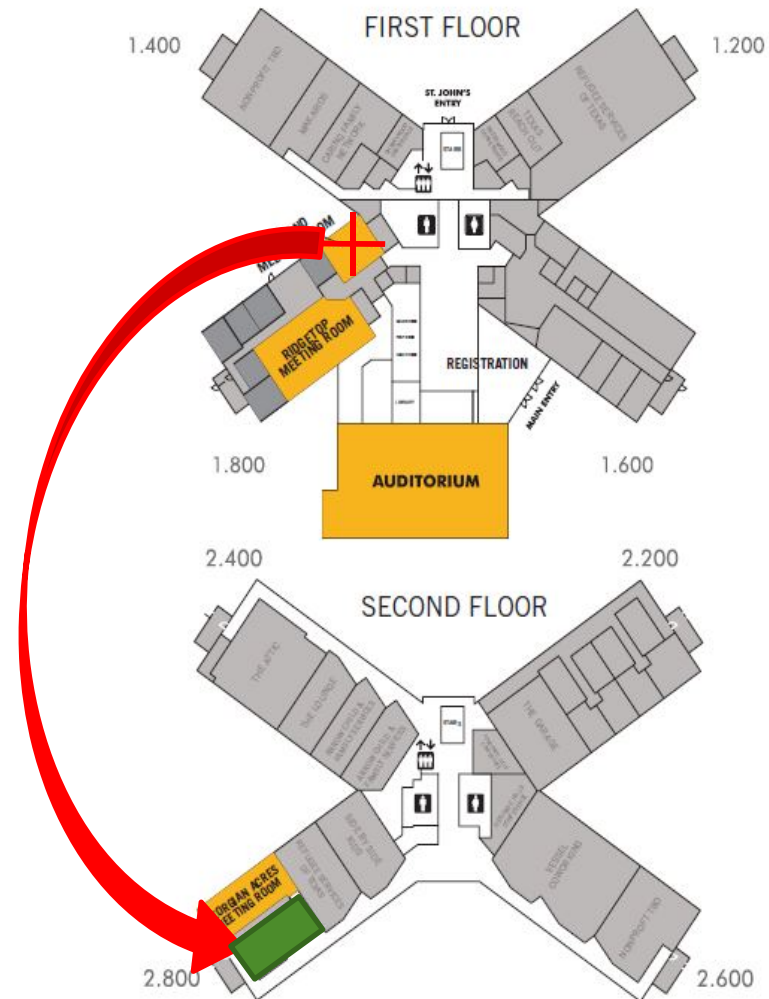
